



Description

You will contribute content to Wikipedia (any language); to the P2P Foundation [wiki](#); to the Appropedia [wiki](#); or to any other community-driven wiki that documents knowledge related to the Urban Commons. The content must be related with theories and practices of the Urban Commons.

Examples and ideas

Three examples are provided to indicate possible contributions that you may have:

1. You may contribute content to existing entries (e.g., [Commons](#); [Elinor Ostrom](#); [Political Ecology](#); [Tragedy of the Commons](#); [Social and Solidarity Economy](#); [Sharing Economy](#); etc.). For example, one contributed a few lines to the [Exarcheia](#) entry about the Park Navarinou, a prominent case of Urban Commons in Athens. Or one could refine the [existing entry](#) of the P2P Foundation wiki on the “Bologna Regulation for the Care and Regeneration of Urban Commons”.
2. You may add a new entry. For example, in Wikipedia (any language) one could create an entry about the “Bologna Regulation for the Care and Regeneration of Urban Commons”.
3. You may expand an existing entry or create a new one about a certain technological artefact that is a commons and is implemented in an urban environment. Such entries are hosted in Appropedia.

Goals

1. To get an in-depth and practical understanding of this course’s core concepts by contributing content that may become publicly available.
2. To experience the processes, the problems and the challenges of prominent (digital) commons cases (Wikipedia, P2P Foundation, Appropedia).
